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About Antigo Visual Arts Public Art Committee:

Antigo Visual Arts (AVA) Public Art Committee was created by AVA members and is part of the nonprofit Langlade County Historical Society with the idea of beautifying our city's downtown. With the help of the City of Antigo and Langlade County Economic Development, AVA's push for murals downtown became reality with the city setting aside \$5000 of a facade grant. Grant money will be utilized on a per project basis, paying 50% (up to a maximum of \$1000 per mural project) made available by the city toward the cost of materials/supplies and the rental of necessary lift equipment.

Artists' Vision Statement: "My vision of my graffiti art mural of "Antigo Pride," is to show our pride in a creative way. To also give artists a chance to show their pride, even in a small city. My style of graffiti will give a jolt of our Pride, and creativity we all have in our own ways." –Emily Popelka

Materials Used and Steps to Execution:

The preparation and process of creating this mural will be determined by the needs of the location. The following process describes the baseline process.

- Surface Preparation
 - The artist will apply an exterior primer to the surface of the building to prepare for the painting application.
- Painting Specifications
 - The artist will use a mixture of roller painting, spray painting, and brushwork to complete the artwork. Rollers will be used to apply the background colors, and spray paint and brushwork will be used for detailed artwork.
- Protective coating:
 - Anti-graffiti coating will be applied to the artwork by the artist at completion of the project.

Re: Zero Turn Mower Purchase from Quinlan's Equipment for \$15,749

We bid a 60" deck zero turn mower and received six bids.

Staff is recommending purchase of the Hustler Z Diesel for \$15,749. We currently have two Hustler zero turns in our fleet, which were purchased in 2018. Both Hustlers have performed very well with minimal maintenance.

Purchasing the same make of equipment creates efficiencies for staff regarding maintenance, repairs and equipment operations.

The low bid from John Deere without trade is: \$14,954.06

The second low bid from Rew Motors Inc. did not meet our specs for HP and without trade is: \$15,589.93

The bid from Quinlan's Equipment for the Hustler Z Diesel without trade is: \$15,749

We currently have \$16,863 budgeted for the mower purchase, and are requesting approval to purchase the Hustler Z Diesel from Quinlan's Equipment for \$15,749.
