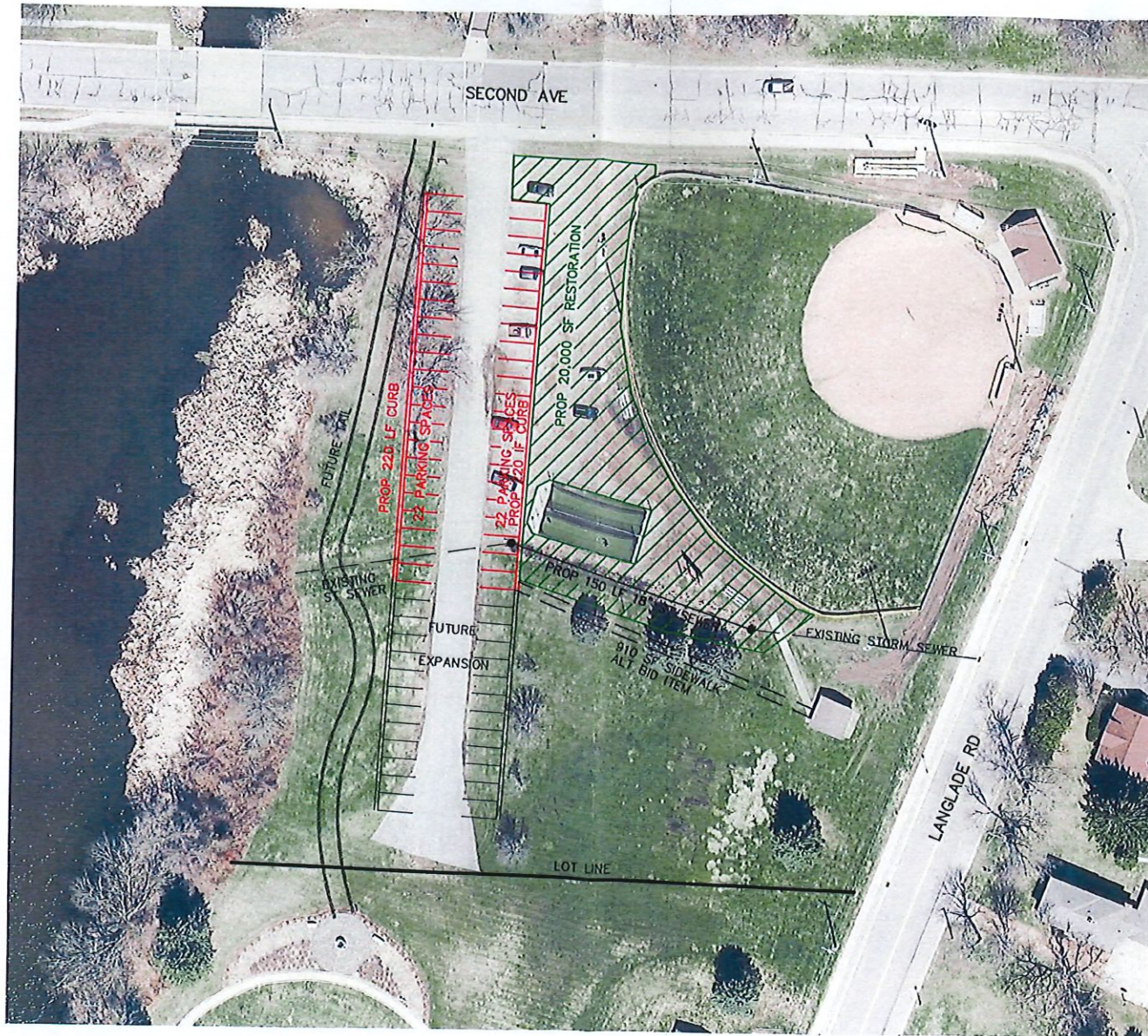

Re: Springbrook Trail Expansion Scope Change Approval to Develop a Designated Trailhead at Al Remington Park

In 2019, we were awarded grant funds for the Springbrook Trail Expansion segment from the existing trail, north along the east edge of the Fairgrounds property, and connecting to North Ave. Following completion of the 1/2 mile segment we had remaining funds. The DNR has approved a scope change allowing us to develop the Al Remington parking area to create additional parking, a walkway along the water, and restoration of the gravel area behind the outfield fence. Al Remington Ball Park has served as an unofficial trail head for access to the Springbrook Trail, boardwalk, and Disc Golf Course. Development of this area through an approved scope change will not only be a benefit to trail users it will also help complete the overall park plans and design adding enhancements to the heavily utilized ball field, and community facility. I am requesting approval to accept the scope change and use remaining budgeted funds to complete the project.

Re: Approval to adjust Pickleball Rates for 2022/2023 Indoor Season

We currently rent gym space at the Boys & Girls Club and All Saints for 9 months of indoor pickleball play.

I am recommending an increase from \$65/season to \$90/season (\$10 per month) to play pickleball from September - May, indoors, at designated locations. With an average of 35-38 registered participants the fee increase will off-set the facility use fees.
