**Re:** Approve Use of Contingency Funds from Heinzen Pavilion and CIP funds for Trail Connections in Peaceful Valley

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Approximately, \$9,000.00 remains as contingency for the Heinzen Peaceful Valley Pavilion Project. I would like to recommend that the funds be applied to trail connections from the Heinzen Pavilion to the existing pathways and Warming House. Additionally, \$6,709.00 is budgeted in CIP for Construction of Parking and Paths. I am recommending a portion of these funds also be applied to the pathway connections; Charley is estimating the pathway connections will cost approximately \$11,000.00.

The Heinzen Pavilion is reserved consistently throughout the spring, summer, and fall. The trail connections will provide accessible pathways to the restroom facilities and warming house, which are utilized when the Pavilion is reserved.
