Re: RC Track Development by Langlade County Radio Control Club in Railway Activity Park

The Railway Activity Park has seen positive development for a variety of recreational activities that can be enjoyed year-round. Generous donations from various community groups and/or organizations and individuals have made these developments possible.

Improvements and development include:

Rotary Sled Hill

Optimist Skate Park

Rotary Bicycle Park & Pump Track

Tree Plantings funded through a DNR Urban Forestry Grant, and donations from WPS and ATC

As we continue to develop the park more user groups and individuals have taken an interest in the various recreational improvements, and park usage has increased.

The Park, Cemetery and Recreation Commission and the City of Antigo Common Council look for ways to offer a variety of low-cost or free recreational opportunities that are accessible to community members and visitors.

The Langlade County Radio Control Club is requesting permission to develop an RC Track in the Railway Activity Park in the south west corner. Below is their proposal, and enclosed is the area they would be using as well as a track layout:

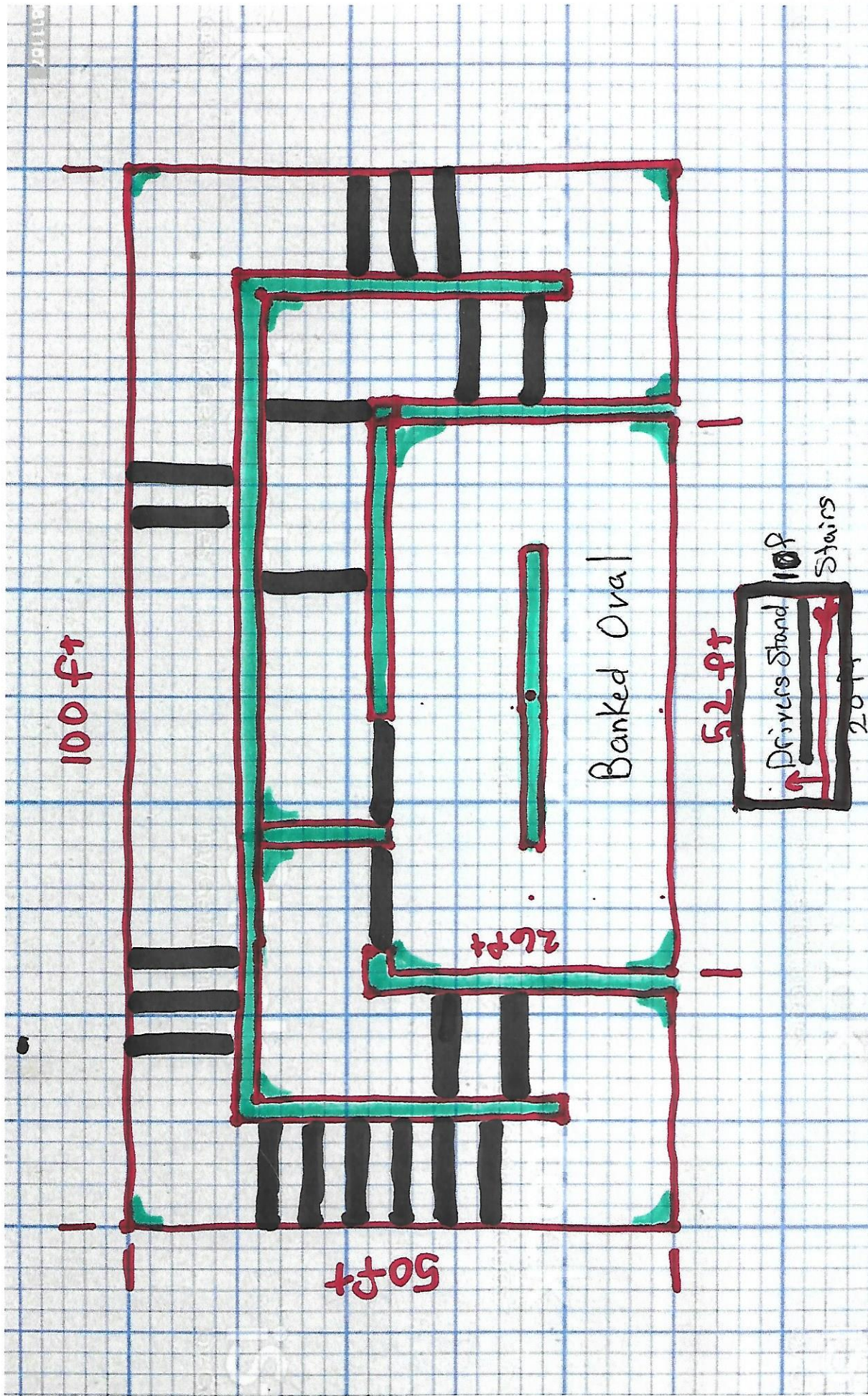
The club will provide materials and labor for the building of the track and drivers stand. As for power and water we may need to address them at a later date due to limited club funds. We will bring water as needed for wetting the track and use generators for power. We can't afford a monthly power and water bill at this time for the small amount of each that we will need.

I am excited to work with the Langlade County Radio Control Club to develop an RC Track in the Railway Activity Park, and am asking for approval to allow for development of the track by the Langlade County Radio Control Club.

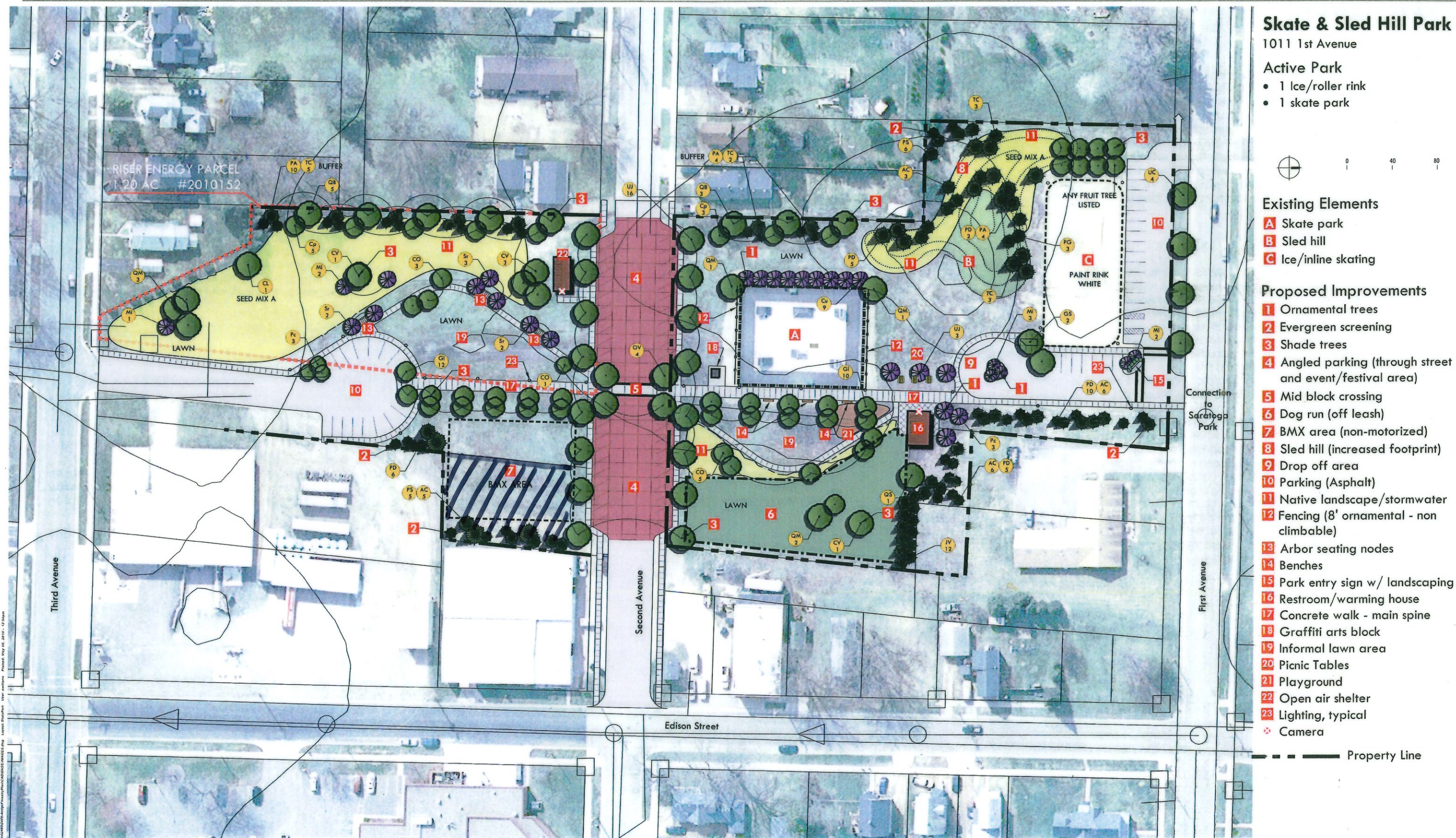


Legend:

Re: Approving Most Advantageous Quote for Concrete At Wright Place Playground

The City of Antigo has been working with Jeanne Long and Alycia Fetterly to install sensory playground equipment and wheelchair swing/rocker at the Wright Place Playground.

Jeanne and Alycia fundraised just over \$26,000 dollars, and the City of Antigo budgeted additional funds for the project.

Crews will be installing the sensory play equipment, but a contractor will be installing the concrete where the sensory play equipment will be placed.

We received two quotes for concrete:

PSI: Total cost to install concrete - \$10,895

G&B: Total cost to install concrete - \$11,500

We are currently working with both contractors for various jobs throughout the city, and both do an excellent job.

I am recommending the quote from PSI for \$10,895 using budgeted CIP funds.
