We decided to re interview instead of use the past eligibility list as the top candidate still did not start the Police Academy and the next applicant was interested in seeking employment in another jurisdiction.

Our last hire Levi Barske is working out well and will be completing Filed Training in the middle of summer.

I will be moving Sergeant Jerry Reichl from night shift sergeant to day shift sergeant at the end of summer as he has requested the lateral transfer. I will be posting to fill for the night shift Sergeant once we get to full staff and will come to Police and Fire Commission for approval of that promotion.
