Re: Approval to Purchase Lifiable Trash Cans for the 5th Avenue Corridor

The local trash collection providers have updated their procedures for trash collection. Any receptacles requiring servicing need to be emptied using their automated system.

The current trash receptacles along the 5th Avenue corridor can not be emptied using an automated system, so they can no longer be serviced by a local trash collection provider as they have in the past.

We are proposing to remove the existing trash receptacles along the 5th Avenue corridor and replace them with receptacles that can be serviced using the automated system.

New trash receptacles will be purchased using approximately \$7,600 from Alley and Boulevard funds. The trash receptacles that are removed will be re-purposed in parks and/or cemeteries.

Re: Mulching Head Bids

The Street Department, Parks Department and Inland Lakes have recently collaborated and took bids for a mulching head for our Doosan 140 DX wheeled excavator.

Five bids were received and were all relatively close. I am recommending the bid from Miller-Bradford in the amount of \$29,575. The mulching head is an Indeco IMH-10 and will be used for removing buckthorn and stumps at Elmwood Cemetery, brush from walking trails and roadsides as well as landfill well sites and bail fills.

Miller-Bradford can deliver March 25th and is based in Wisconsin.

Approval to award the bid to Miller-Bradford for \$29,575.
