There has been discussion amongst staff regarding the method of snow removal in the downtown area to minimize wear and tear on the new sidewalk/curb and gutter. Staff would like to purchase an articulating tractor with a broom, v-plow, and snow blower to use on the outer edges of the sidewalk so that a loader does not have to scrape the area. The Street Commissioner is in the process of bidding for a tractor with the bids being due on Monday, October 12th. The bid results and more information will be presented to the Public Works Committee for review.

The funds for this purchase would be from the Capital Equipment/Improvement Fund for equipment and from the sale proceeds of the grader.

If approved by Public Works, there is an item on the Council agenda for approval.

Re: Accept Proposal for Engineering Services for the 2021 Fifth Avenue Reconstruction Project from Lincoln Street to Western Avenue (bids will be presented after opened on October 12, 2020)

At the September 23, 2020, Public Works Committee meeting, Mark Desotell, Director of Administrative Services, received approval to solicit price proposals from MSA Professional Services and Ayres Associates for engineering services associated with the 2021 Fifth Avenue reconstruction project from Lincoln Street to Western Avenue.

The proposals are due on October 12, 2020, and will be distributed to the Committee for approval. There will also be a resolution on the Council agenda on the same night for approval based on the Committee's recommendation. There will be a recommendation from staff after the bids are opened and reviewed.

The timing for this action is crucial as the on-site surveys that are required for the project need to occur prior to the onset of winter conditions in order to assure a spring construction.
