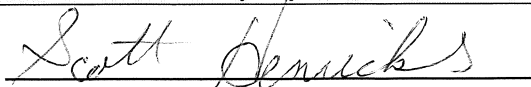
Any Other Matters Authorized by Law to be Considered

Charley Brinkmeier, Land Surveyor/Project Manager, gave a review and the status of the current projects being completed in the City. Mr. Brinkmeier stated the Edison Street Project is a little behind, he has a different contractor working on the curb and sidewalk. He stated the water tower is potentially getting filled next week, they are waiting on the prime contractor before they can fill the water tower. The bridge project on Fourth Avenue is nearing completion, he noted the rest of Fourth Avenue is on schedule. Mr. Brinkmeier stated an issue with a watermain not passing pressure tests, he noted it is currently being worked on. Mayor Bauknecht asked if the Lake will be raised after the Fourth Avenue bridge is completed. Mr. Packard stated it would not due to other projects that still need to be completed and the time of year.
