4. Allow Fire Chief to Bid on a Used Fire Truck and Set a Not to Exceed Amount

Corey Smith, Fire Chief, stated this item is at this meeting due to the timing of a 2021 fire truck being up for auction that ends tomorrow. Upon inquiry from Aldersperson Smith, Chief Smith noted the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) recommends a fire truck be refurbished at 15 years and retired completely at 25 years old, noting the City's current fire truck is 28 years old. Chief Smith stated a new fire truck is close to one million dollars.
