Antigo First is planning an event to celebrate the re-opening of 5th Avenue after the reconstruction last summer. They are planning to close the 700 to 1000 blocks of 5th Avenue to traffic from 8 am to 11 pm allowing for music, activities and food vendors to add to the celebration. They have reached out to numerous groups (see attached yellow sheet) to offer a chance to do fundraising activities and/or selling food items at this event but there is not a fee to attend the event.

Antigo First has presented a request to waive the permit fee and the insurance requirement for this event and would appreciate the Committee's approval.

Re: Request to Waive the Bid Process & to Accept a Quote from Frisch's Greenhouse for the 2021 Landscape Planting Program to include Hanging Baskets/Ground Planters for the Downtown, Peaceful Valley Park, Springbrook Walking Trail, City Hall and other Miscellaneous Location

We have nearly completed the Downtown 5th Avenue reconstruction project (Highway 45 to Lincoln St) with the decorative street light poles having been placed over the past week. Each pole is equipped to receive with a hanging basket attachment in-place. The concrete decorative ground planters are in storage and City crews are ready to place them once weather breaks. The plantings are scheduled to arrive as part of the 5th Avenue project.

Once the plants arrive we are anticipating that Frisch's Greenhouse will plant and maintain them subject to your consideration and Council's approval of the overall planting program. The annual program includes such things as our traditional hanging basket program, ground planters in the Downtown & Peaceful Valley, City Hall, Parks and other miscellaneous areas.

The Downtown Antigo First Group continues to support the effort annually in the amount of \$3,500; once again they plan to schedule fund raising events accordingly. In fact, their first event is scheduled for Saturday June 12th as a celebration of the project completion.

Frisch's Greenhouse assisted the City in the development of this program and have done a fantastic job to assure that the baskets and other plantings are well maintained. It is my recommendation to waive the bidding process for the 2021 planting program and to approve a quote (see attached in your agenda packets) from Frisch's Greenhouse according to the following:

Downtown Program

- \$3,800 for the Hanging Basket Program
- \$ 385 for 3 additional outlying baskets on the south end of Hwy 45
- \$1,885 to \$1,990 for the new ground planters along 5th Ave. (Hwy 45 to Lincoln)
 - Cost of the plants paid for under the construction project

Parks & Miscellaneous Program

- \$2,350 for planting sites along Springbrook Walking Trail

-
- \$ 655 to \$ 710 for the new ground planters at the City's Dog Park
 - \$6,570 to \$8,650 for the 6th Avenue/Peaceful Valley ground planting displays
 - \$ 452 for the weekender baskets on light poles at peaceful Valley (Field St/6th Ave)
 - \$945.50 for Miscellaneous plantings at City Hall, Lake Park & the campground

Notes/Comments:

- The variable amounts depend on the actual # months of watering and any ability for utilizing the automatic watering system based on weather conditions
- Frish's Greenhouse requests a 25% down payment for some of the above items based upon the initial planting/growing costs

Due to the recent increases in natural gas heating costs not yet being fully realized by Frish's Greenhouse it may be necessary to negotiate a one-time "sur-charge" adjustment to the above quoted costs in order to offset increased costs to heat the greenhouse during the pre-season planting period.

Due to the abnormal cold in Texas, we are expecting dramatic increases in heating prices. We will try to mitigate this concern, but you will be seeing prices above and beyond what we've quoted.

Also, with the severe weather that hit Memphis, the Fed Ex hub for the US is impacting all plant and seed deliveries throughout the nation. What does this mean for you and Frisch Greenhouses? There is a high probability that some of the plant material that you requested might not be available. We will be working with our suppliers throughout the coming weeks to try to fulfill these requests. We might have to substitute other varieties and may possibly have to delay delivery.

For the perennials that you requested us to plant in the downtown landscaping containers, we strongly suggest you check with your suppliers so that they will have this material available at the appropriate time.

All plant materials will be provided and delivered by the City of Antigo to Frisch Greenhouses during late April or early May, weather permitting.
