Re: Consider Antigo Area Recreation Foundation's Request for use of a portion of City-owned property within Saratoga Park for the Development of a Multi-use Recreational Facility in Cooperation with Pickleball and Baseball Groups for a Non-State Grant Application through the Wisconsin Department of Administration

A Non-State Grant Program application through the Wisconsin Department of Administration is being sought locally for the construction of a multi-use recreational facility. The project application is being advanced through the Antigo Area Recreation Foundation on behalf of pickleball and baseball interests with other potential partners yet to be determined. The Non-State Grant Program provides successful applicants with 50% project funding with the remainder to be locally matched. The interest groups are confident in their ability to secure a commitment for matching funds prior to the application deadline in late January of 2024.

The City Plan Commission is being asked to approve the group's proposed use of a Saratoga Park location (see attached). Separate agenda items for PRC & FP&L will be developed as necessary. The proposed building will likely have a design component allowing for the use of restrooms and shower/locker room areas by those utilizing the City's proposed overflow campground to be located immediately south of this proposed project site.

This grant program is anticipated as a one-time opportunity as it is being funded utilizing Badger Bounceback funding made available through ARPA dollars.

Should the project scope grow beyond the ability to accommodate the group's request at the Saratoga Park site or should a more suitable site be mutually identified, the Antigo Area Recreation Foundation and their project partners will return to the City Plan Commission for discussions regarding alternate locations for the project.
